1. For example, house A in an area *zoned* for residential use may have a highest and best use as vacant and a highest and best use as improved that are both residential.
2. A similar house B in a commercially *zoned* area may have a highest and best use as vacant as development to a commercial development, and the highest and best use as improved may be for continued use as a single family residence.
3. This may exclude uses that are not, and unlikely to become, permitted by zoning, land use planning, uses forbidden by government regulations, and uses prohibited by deed restrictions or covenants.
4. On 29 January 2014, Shanghai's *urban planning* authorities announced that they would build a second bridge combining road and rail to help meet growing transport demands for the Yangshan deep-water port.
5. The medieval abbey church that originally stood on this location was demolished by command of Charles Alexander of Lorraine during his expansive urban planning projects, despite having escaped the great fire of 1731 that destroyed the nearby Coudenberg Palace.
6. In the latter case, hazard assessment means identifying areas on a municipal scale that, in the event of a seismic tremor, may be subject to amplification phenomena and provide data useful for urban planning.

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
